This is an early 3-bay side-passage stone residence of two stories, with flat-topped fenestration, nine over six. The building is built of coursed rubble, with larger stone quoins at the corners. A substantial two story, non-historic brick addition has been built onto the left gable end.

Several dependencies are located in proximity to the in house including a two-story residential building with the first story of stone and the second story of wood frame. A two-car modern brick garage stands beside the house, and beyond is a substantial timber frame bank barn set on a course rubble limestone foundation.
